EYFS (Reception Class)

Reception children are assessed against the early learning goals in the 3 prime areas (PSED, Communication and Language and Physical Development) as well as the specific areas (Literacy and Numeracy). If children achieve the expected level in all of these areas, they achieve a 'good level of development (GLD)'.

Multiplication Check (Year 4)

All pupils in Year 4 take part in a multiplication check. The check has 25 questions and tests pupils on their multiplication facts. Pupils only have 6 seconds per question. The Government does not release a pass mark for this but does release average data. Those pupils below the average score will continue to receive support the following academic year.
