Dear Parents/Carers

Borth, Wales residential visit – Monday 22nd May – Friday 26th May

The Class 6 trip is fast approaching so we thought some key bits of information may be useful. The initial meeting presentation and parents' information booklet, that we shared in October, can be found on the Class 6 page of our website should you want to refresh your memory.

Electrical equipment

Children are not permitted to bring any electrical equipment other than a camera (mobile phones are not permitted as cameras). Regarding mobiles, contacting home can make the children homesick and unsettled. If for any reason you urgently need to contact your child it can be done via the school office. The children will be wholly responsible for their cameras during the day time. Please ensure they are named, as they will be looked after by staff at night. We also ask that the children do not take photos of each other whilst on the coach. Please complete the equipment register to confirm that your child has a camera with them either after school on Friday 19th or on Monday 22nd morning.

Medicines and spending money

Medicines (including travel sickness) and spending money should be given to Mrs Arnaud and Mrs Watkins at the end of the school day on Friday 19th May on the playground. Please make sure you retain a travel sickness tablet to give your child on Monday morning should they require them. If you have any last minute queries, please call in to see us at this time.

Daily spending money (max of £5 per day for Monday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday) will be given out at breakfast. It must be sealed in four separate envelopes, and each envelope clearly labelled with the child's name, day and amount contained.

Monday Departure

Children should arrive at school at 8am (we will be leaving promptly at 8:30am). If you have medication or spending money still to hand over or anything to discuss, staff will be available. Children must go straight to the hall for check in. Luggage can be left on the number square outside the hall door. Parents are asked to wait outside in the playground or near the park so that we can organize the children for departure. If your child requires travel sickness medication, please give this to your child before coming to school. Please ensure your child has their packed lunch, in a disposable bag, within their rucksack and plenty of water in a refillable water bottle.

Post Cards

We hope that the children will send a post card home during the trip. Can you please attach a stamp and add your home address to the blank post card your child brings home today and send it back to school as soon as possible? If parents live in separate homes, please stamp and address a post card for each, if you'd like to.

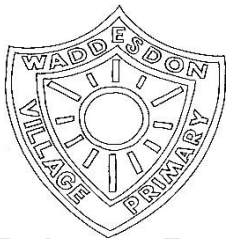
Suggested packing list

- Teddy

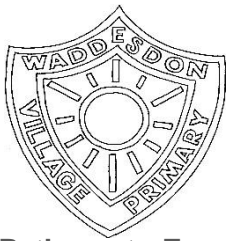
