

Spring Term 1 2023

Class 6 Home Learning

There are 3 areas of homework to complete each week:

1. **Reading:** You should read for 20 minutes each day, including 1 day each week from a book on Bug Club. The expectation is that you will record the 4 days when you have read your reading book at home in your Reading Record and hand this in each Monday. Your Reading Record will be returned back to you on the same day. Your teacher will be able to see your Progress on **Bug Club**. When you read, think about what you have read, collect examples of rich vocabulary and discuss your book with an adult regularly. Vary the authors, genres and text types you select and strive to read from the Reading Rocket selection often.
2. **Maths:** You should log on to Times **Tables Rock Stars and Numbots** at home at least 3 times each week to practise your tables and arithmetic skills.
3. **SAT Busters:** Each week, you need to complete the 3 SAT Buster 'tests' from your 3 books as detailed in the table below and bring these in each Monday. Whilst the books suggest 10 minutes for each, at this stage, it is OK to spend 15-20 minutes on each if you need to. Try and have a go at all of the questions. Feel free to look up any terminology or methods that may help you as you learn. Remember that you have from Thursday – Sunday to complete these and this gives you plenty of time to ask Mrs Swanson about any questions you are unsure of. It is important that **all 3 books are brought into school each Monday** so that we can mark the tests together in class and discuss any tricky areas or new learning. If you have your books, with your answers, then the learning experience for you will be greatly improved during these sessions.

There is a chart in your Reading Record to tick off each part of your homework daily so that you don't forget anything. Trying your very best, being organised with homework and meeting these expectations will result in house points, stickers or certificates and, of course, you will be learning, practising key skills and becoming an independent learner.

If any of the 3 homework expectations are not fully complete, the sanction will be to complete the missing work during break time. If there is more than 1 expectation missing, you will also need to stay in for subsequent break times.
