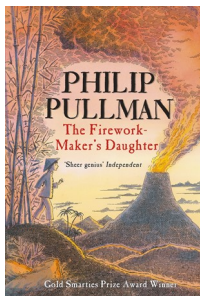


English

Our core text this half term is 'The Firework-Maker's Daughter' by Philip Pullman.

This book will give children the opportunity to develop their writing through diary entries, detailed setting descriptions and poetry. Children will be able to apply their learning in SPaG to write conversations between characters, using direct speech. As well as this, children will be acting in character through hot seating and freeze framing.

Children will have the opportunity to develop their comprehension skills through daily whole class reading sessions. In addition to this, children will have spelling, grammar and handwriting



Science

This half term the children will be learning about Light and Shadow. This unit will allow children to learn about the sun and its features. They will then use this knowledge to think about how and why shadows are formed. Experiments will be conducted into length of shadows throughout the day and children will be able to explain why and when a shadow is shorter or longer.

Tuesday: Homework to be handed in.

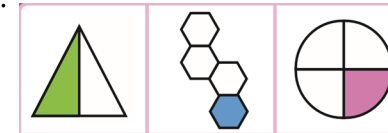
Thursday (PM): Mrs Arnaud and Mrs Watkins (PM) and Exposure Sports (PE).

Mathematics

The children will be consolidating their understanding of subtraction by using column subtraction.

Following this, we will be learning about fractions. Children will be able to recognise, find and write fractions of a set of objects using unit fractions. The children will learn how to add, subtract and compare fractions as well as find equivalent fractions.



PE

I will teach PE on a Monday afternoon. Children will be introduced to the sport of volleyball and learn the skills involved.

PE with Exposure Sport will be on Thursday afternoon. Children will be developing their athletic skills and have the opportunity to practise a range of athletic events.

RE

This half term the children will have the opportunity to learn about the different Gods that Hindu's worship. They will look at the Trimurti. They will also spend time learning how Hindu's worship their Gods at home and in their temple.

History

The children will be learning about The Romans this half term. Children will consider the effects of the invasion and settlement of the Romans on Britain. We will discuss how artefacts help us learn about the past.



Children will be learning about what Romans did for fun and what was important to the Romans.

DT & Art

This half term the children will be learning how to make a Roman pouch. They will be designing and making their own pouch using various materials and developing their sewing skills. Children will look at the purpose of pouches during the Roman period.



Music

This half term the children will be learning about composing melodies. This learning will be linked to China.



Computing

Children will be learning about databases and how to input data using the Purple Mash software. They will also be looking at Internet Safety and how to stay safe online.

How you can support your child at home:

Enjoy reading to your child and listening to your child read. Show them how you read for pleasure and discuss how reading helps you each day demonstrating your comprehension skills. Ensure your child brings in their reading record at least once a week for it to be checked.

Celebrate your child selecting a book from the Reading Rocket Challenge or one that is different from the type/author that they would usually pick.

Look for rich vocabulary together in books and films then make a note of these words and try to use them in everyday conversations.

Discuss which spellings they found tricky this week in their writing and encourage them to try a range of strategies to help remember.

Discuss times table facts and encourage your child to regularly log onto Times Table Rockstars or Numbots at home.

PSHE

This half term children will be exploring a variety of different themes, including 'Relationships'. Through discussion, circle time, drama and practical activities children will know how to respect other peoples physical and cultural differences.
