Dear parents and carers

Legoland

I am delighted to confirm that the Class 6 visit to Legoland on Friday 13th May can go ahead – thank you so much for your contributions towards this. There are a few things that you need to be aware of so that your child is ready for the trip:

Departure/Return times

Children will need to arrive at school at the earlier time of 8am so that we can set off at 8:15am. We will leave Legoland at 5pm and hope to be back at school for 6:30pm; we will keep you up to date with any changes to expected return time via parentmail.

Clothing

Depending on the weather, children should wear a t-shirt or long sleeved top and shorts/leggings/jeans (not dresses or skirts) plus a hoody and sun hat. Sensible, secure shoes, such as trainers rather than sandals, need to be worn. If rain or cold weather is forecast, you may also want to send a light coat.

Backpack

A small backpack to carry sun cream, hoody (when they take it off), plenty of water, snack and lunch is required. For a packed lunch to be provided by Fresh Start, you will need to have ordered a meal on this day AND selected a sandwich (i.e. Ham or Cheese) under 'Meal Replacement' via the Preferences on their website.

Mobiles

Children's mobile phones are not permitted on this trip so please ensure these are not sent with them to school that day.

Spending Money

We will not be visiting the gift shop in order to maximise our time in the park. Also, items are costly and there are very little 'pocket money' type products available. However, we hope to pass an ice-cream stand at some point during the day. Your child may bring £3 only in a small purse/wallet if they would like to buy one. They should put this safely in their bag.

Cameras

There is no need to bring a camera, but if your child would really like to, we suggest a disposable one would be most suitable in view of the water rides and risk of losing it.

COVID-19

Legoland has the Visit England 'Good to Go' industry charter mark which means they meet the Government and public health guidance on COVID-19 and that they have all the required health and safety processes in place to safely be open. Of course, just as with a regular school day, your child should not attend if they are unwell and have a high temperature, or have tested positive with COVID-19.
