English

Our core text this half term is 'Arthur and the Golden Rope' by Joe Todd Stanton.

This book will give children the opportunity to learn about the features of a graphic novel as they join Arthur on an adventure to the land of the Viking gods. The children will be developing their creative writing skills through the art of ancient storytelling, writing in role, looking at the features of letters and writing their own adventure stories.

Children will have the opportunity to develop their comprehension skills through weekly whole class reading sessions. In addition to this, children will have weekly spelling, grammar and handwriting sessions.

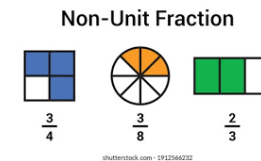


Mathematics

This half term, children will be applying last half-term's learning of unit fractions to learn about non-unit fractions.

Children will be identifying, naming and drawing non-unit fractions. Children will also apply their understanding to word problems involving non-unit fractions.

Following this, children will also consolidate their understanding of time and shape.



PE

PE with myself will be on Monday afternoon. Children will be introduced to the sport of Rounders and learn the skills involved.

PE with Exposure Sport will be on Thursday afternoon. Children will continue to develop their athletic skills and have the opportunity to practise a range of athletic events.

Science

The children will be consolidating their learning of all the Science topics that they have studied this year.

They will have the opportunity to work like scientists: making predictions, carrying out experiments and writing conclusions.

History

The children will continue to learn about the Romans particularly focusing on their lifestyles. We will be learning about what the Romans ate and wore, where they lived and what they did for fun. The children will consider what impact the Romans left on our own lives today and what information archaeological sites tell us about the past.



DT & Art

This half term, children will be learning about the lifestyles of Romans particularly the food they ate. Children will have the opportunity to develop their food technology skills. The children will have the opportunity to take part in a Roman banquet during their Roman Day.



Music

This half term, children will be focusing on their vocals. The topic will explore The Vikings, linking with our class text. Children will sing and perform to others.



Computing

The children will look at Simulations using the programme 2Simulate in Purple Mash. They will also look at creating graphs using the programme 2Graph.

How you can support your child at home:

Enjoy reading to your child and listening to your child read. Show them how you read for pleasure and discuss how reading helps you each day demonstrating your comprehension skills. Reading books will be changed once a week on a Friday.

Celebrate your child selecting a book from the Reading Rocket Challenge or one that is different from the type/author that they would usually pick.

Look for rich vocabulary together in books and films then make a note of these words and try to use them in everyday conversations.

Discuss which spellings they found tricky this week in their writing and encourage them to try a range of strategies to help remember.

Discuss times table facts and encourage your child to regularly log onto Times Table Rockstars or Numbots at home.

PSHE

This half term the children will be taught our Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE) unit. Through the topic 'Changing Me', children will explore a variety of different themes.
