

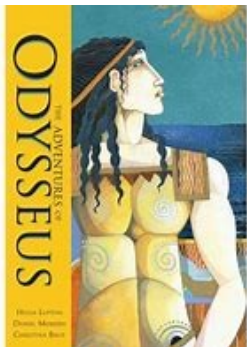

Class 6 will consider the question: Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives? (Islam)



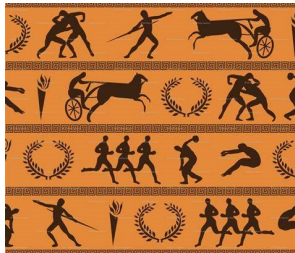

Rehearsing songs for the performance and leavers' assembly.

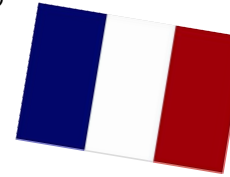
