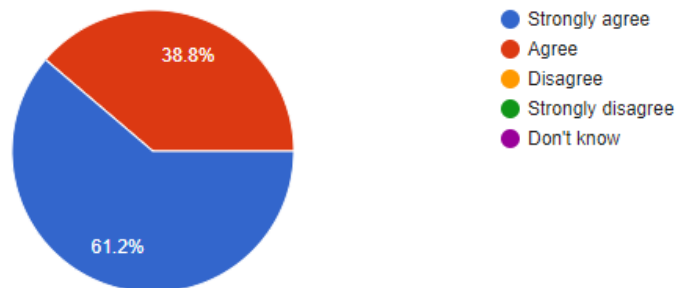

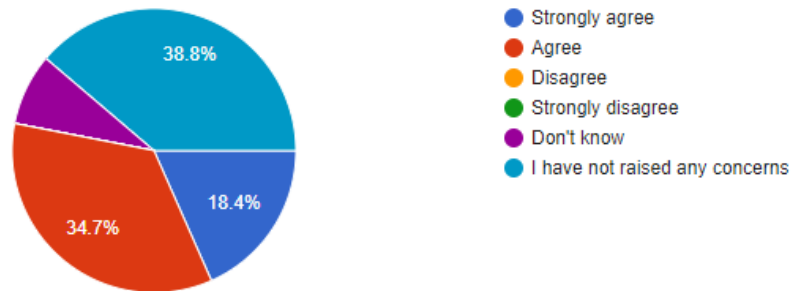

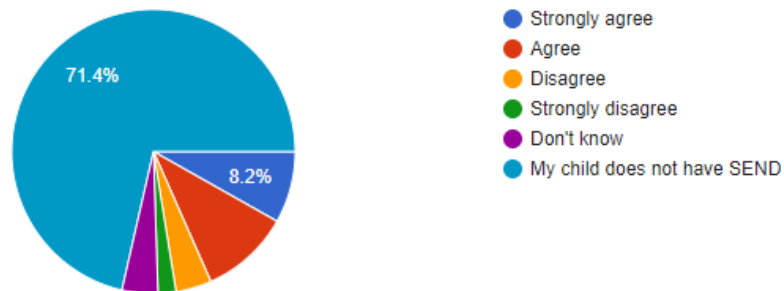

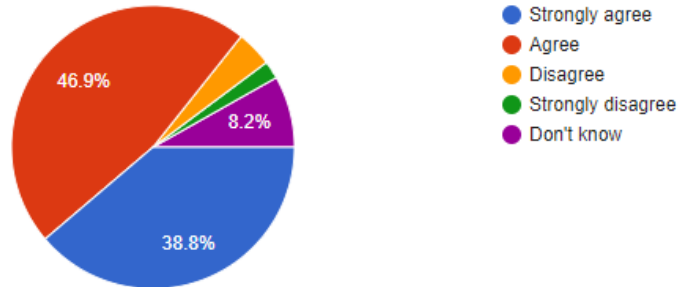

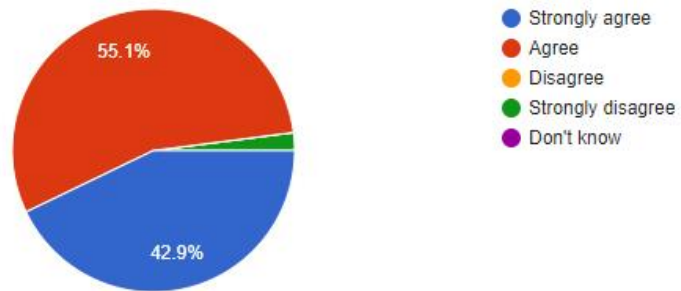

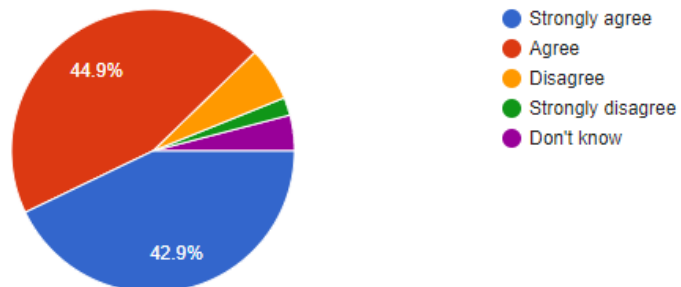

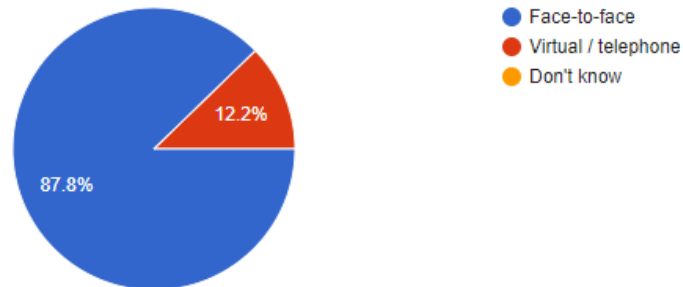

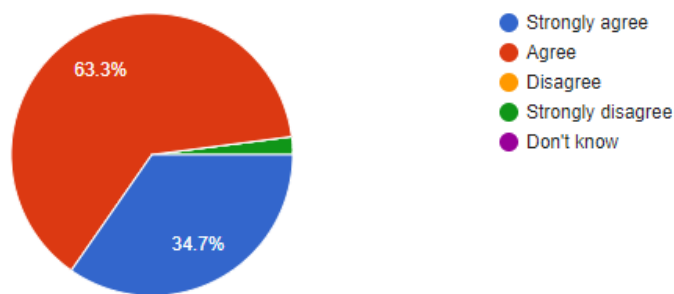

Which of these statements best describes your attitude to your child's homework?

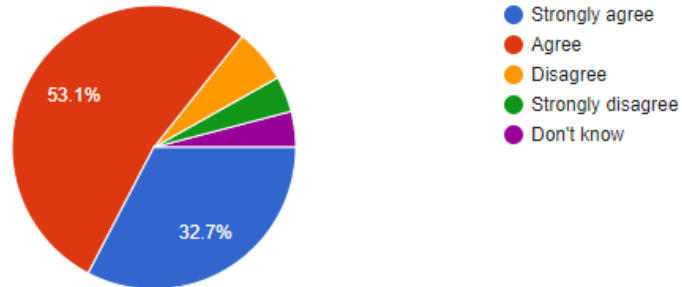

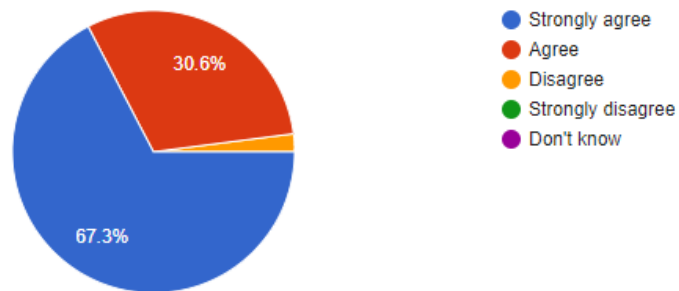

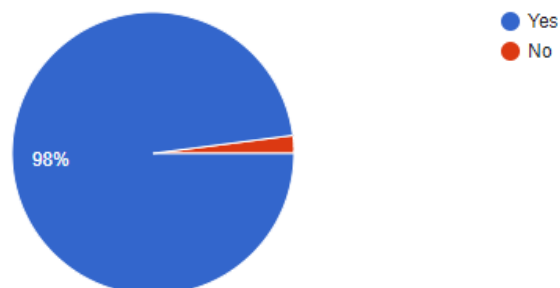
