

Topic: Extreme Earth

<p><i>Welcome back Class 4!</i></p> <p><i>I can't believe we are already in Autumn 2 - it has flown by! Children and families, thank you all for making me feel very welcome to WVPS. Class 4, well done for the progress made over the first half term - let's continue to work hard, work together and have fun.</i></p> <p><i>This half term, we are moving on from mountains to find out about volcanoes.  <p>English</p> <p>Our core text for this half term is a book called 'Escape from Pompeii'. This story has links to our Geography topic. Using this text, we will be able to understand the timeline of events at Pompeii when Vesuvius erupted in AD79, and we will read about how any survivors managed to get away. We will be using this text to write a descriptive recount of the events in Pompeii. This text has a rich vocabulary and the language should encourage lots of class discussion. We will then move onto a short video called 'The Creature' which will inspire a newspaper report.</p>	<p>Mathematics</p> <p>This half term, children will be concentrating on calculating the perimeter of different shapes, both regular and irregular. We will concentrate on the multiplication and division operations and their related facts. The expectation is that children know all their tables up to 12X12 by the end of Year 4 and this will help them with these methods. We will not only be looking at formal written methods but working to improve mental maths skills. Throughout all maths units the pupils will have the opportunity to practise their problem solving and reasoning skills, in familiar and unfamiliar contexts.</p>
<p>Computing</p> <p>This half term, the children will learn how to code using the Purple Mash program, this will allow the children to apply their knowledge learnt from the previous Logo unit.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>The topic this half term is Sound. Children will be looking at how sound is made, objects that make sound, and volume and pitch. They will also look at how sound travels through our ears to our brain. During this topic we will also focus on investigative skills.</p>

<p>PE On Tuesday mornings, we will be going swimming. On Wednesday PE lessons, led by an Exposure Sports coach, the children will be practising their football skills.</p>	<p>Music The Kapow music scheme will be followed. This half term they will be learning about the origin and features of rock and roll music, focusing on the Hand Jive and Rock Around the Clock, looking specifically at a walking bass line, before then performing a piece as a class.</p>	
	<p>Art We will also be studying paintings by the artist Andy Warhol, focussing on a series of 18 paintings called 'Vesuvius by Warhol' to link with our Geography topic and core text Escape from Pompeii. We will also be creating our own versions.</p>	<p>MFL French will continue to be taught by Mr Mitchener on Thursday mornings. He will be following the Rigolo scheme of French work.</p>
<p>RE This half term, we will be revisiting the Christmas Story with a particular focus on how symbols are used as representations. We will also discuss the symbols used in Christingle.</p>	<p>Geography We will continue our unit about mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes. The children will investigate Tectonic Plates and the Earth's crust to find out how earthquakes and volcanoes occur. Our core text will help us to understand the destruction that can be caused.</p>	
<p>PSHE This half term, pupils will follow the Kapow scheme of work. The unit is called "Families and Relationships" and the pupils will be learning about the boundaries in friendships, and how what they do and say affects other people.</p>		
<p>How you can support your child at home? Children will be receiving home learning which is due in on a Monday. Home learning will be linked to what the children are learning in Maths and English. As a school, we are continuing to have a big push on children reading for pleasure. To support this, please could you encourage your children to read every night. Rich texts can be accessed via our 'Rocket Reading Challenge'. Pupils will continue to have weekly times tables tests. Please could you help your children practise these and complete set tasks on 'Times Tables Rock Stars'. Pupils will have the Year 3 and 4 spelling list in the front of homework books and the expectation is that children can spell these words, and use them in their writing by the end of the year. They have been highlighted to show which words they need to work on. Your support is vital and much appreciated.
