

## **Work for Wednesday**

### **Reading Comprehension**

For this activity, your child is expected to read the story without help from an adult. So, choose the best level for them. If they need a little help, you could read it to them and then encourage them to answer the questions independently.

### **Maths**

In class, we have been recapping o'clock and half past times from Year 1. We have also built on this knowledge and started looking at quarter past and quarter to times.

Make a clock of your own at home and practise making these times:

1. Quarter past 1
2. Quarter past 4
3. Quarter past 7
4. Quarter past 10
5. Quarter to 3
6. Quarter to 5
7. Quarter to 8
8. Quarter to 12

### **Spelling**

We have been looking at the spelling rule: take off the 'y' and add an 'i', with words ending in -ed, -er and -est.

E.g. dotty – dottier – dottiest

Practise spelling words correctly by completing the activity sheet.

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### **Writing instructions**

Design your own delicious ice cream sundae! First, think of a fun name for your creation to use as your title e.g. Berry Bonanza! Next, choose your favourite ice cream flavours and decide which tasty toppings you would like to add.

Use one of the templates provided to write clear instructions explaining how to make your sundae. Remember to put your instructions in the correct order and use time words such as first, next, then and finally.

As an extra challenge, you could draw a colourful picture of your ice cream sundae and label the different parts!

### **Maths**

Practise drawing quarter past and quarter to times on the worksheets provided. You could use the clock you made yesterday to help you.

In class, we have been focusing on how the minute hand should be longer and the hour hand should be shorter.

### **Spelling**

Play the Read and Race spelling games to practise words with suffixes -ed, -ing, -er and -est. Take turns to roll a dice and move your counter. When you land on the word, read it aloud carefully. Keep going until somebody reaches the finish line!
