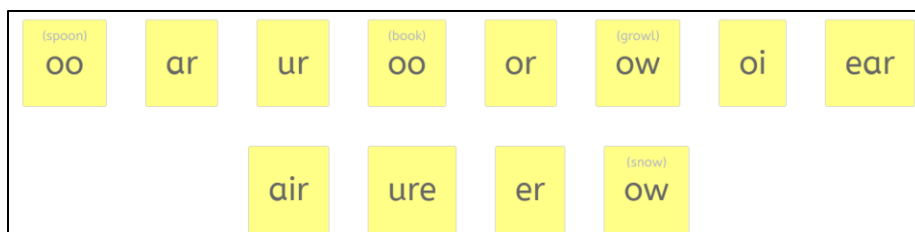
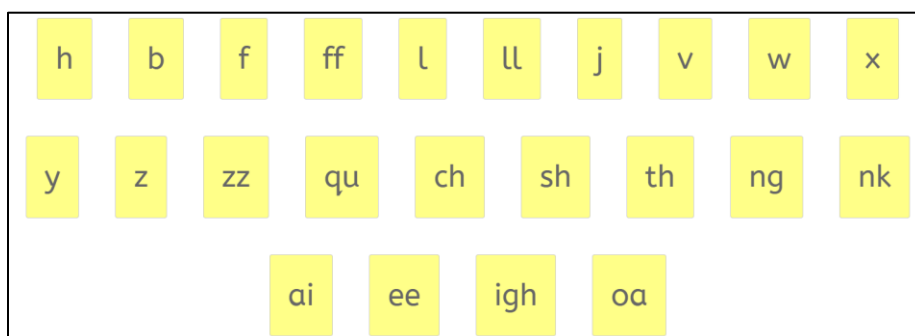
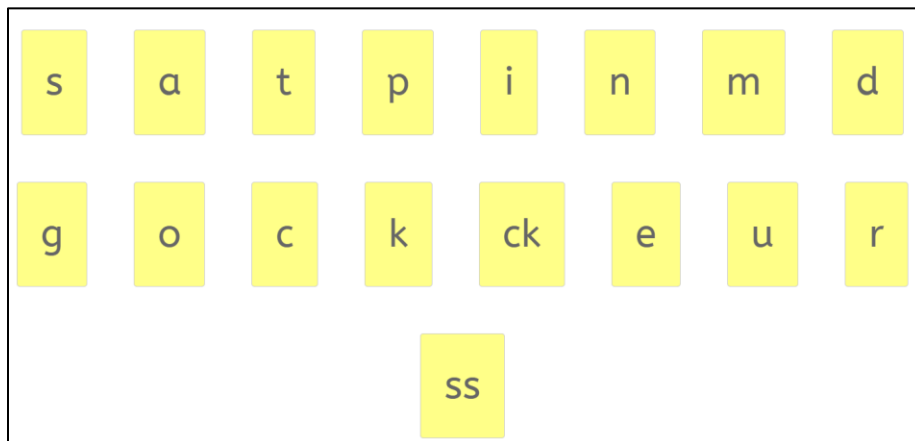


Wednesday

Phonics:
