Thank you very much to parents and carers for completing the questionnaire about our schools' approaches to behaviour. We had 35 responses in total (1 response = 2.86%) The results of this survey have been shared with governors and staff. Our future actions will feed in to our School Development Plan for 2025/2026 as we will be implementing a new 'Behaviour and Relationship Policy'.

<u>What you said we do well</u>	<u>What you feel we need to develop</u>
94% of parents feel that behaviour at Waddesdon Village Primary School is good and that there are clear routines and expectations in place.	Some parents felt that older children lost their enthusiasm for the rainbow system as they reached the top of the school.
Many parents felt that the rainbow and points reward schemes worked well with their children, particularly younger pupils.	Some parents commented that they would like it to be made clearer about how persistent challenging behaviour is dealt with.
Some parents spoke positively about the use of 'zones of regulation' with their children and how this has had a positive impact.	A parent suggested opportunities for pupils to reflect on their behaviour choices to be embedded in the behaviour policy more.
Many felt that children responded well to awards/ certificates given out in assembly for achievement and effort.	Some parents commented that they would like to hear more about positive behaviour choices their children were making.
